IMPLEMENTATION OF HYDRO ELECTRIC PROJECT
IN
ARUNACHAL PRADESH

Secretary (Power) on behalf of Governor of Arunachal Pradesh invites proposal from bidders for the implementation of the Hydro Electric Project in the Private Sector/Joint Sector in Build, Own, Operate and Transfer basis (BOOT), as given under:

The Bidder shall mean a Company or a Consortium of Companies or a Corporation, either in the Public or Private Sector and either of Indian or Foreign Origin.


GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The bidder should have strong financial and technical base with adequate free investible reserves and surpluses and requisite technical capability necessary for the development of the above Hydro Electric Projects. They should furnish their annual Turn Over for the last 5 (five) years, which should not be less than Rs. 500 crores (Rupees Five Hundred Cores) in a single year and should not be a loss making company in last 3 (three) financial years as per audited accounts. The bidder should have capabilities in development of Hydro Power Projects and other infrastructure development. In case of Consortium, each joint venture partner should pre-qualify independently either or both the criteria.
2. For the projects mentioned at the Sl. No. 12 & 13 following additional qualifying criteria shall be necessary.
 - i) The bidder should have their own Hydro Power Generation capacity aggregating minimum 500 MW through one or more Hydro Power Stations during the last 7 (seven) years.
 - ii) The bidder should have net worth not less than Rs. 1000 crores (Rupees One Thousand Crores), for at least last 3 (three) successive years including the financial year 2006-07.
 - iii) In case of consortium, each joint venture partners should pre-qualify independently either or both the conditions (i) & (ii) above.
3. The bidder may participate in one or more projects subject to fulfillments of the above qualifying conditions.
4. The operation period of the Project shall be for a minimum period of 40 (forty) years from the Commercial Operation Date (COD) of the Project at the end of which period, the above Project shall stand transferred to the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, free of cost.
5. For Projects above 100 MW installed capacity, the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh reserves the right of equity participation on selective basis.

6. The Developers will be free to dispose of power from the Project, after allowing for royalty in the shape of free power to the State, in any manner they like in accordance with the provisions contained in the Electricity Act, 2003 and the rules and regulations made thereunder.
7. The Project Developer will be required to provide royalty in the shape of free power from the Project to the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh in lieu of distress caused to the State. The royalty in the shape of free power shall start accruing from the date of commercial operation of the Project.
8. The developer shall reimburse to the concerned authorities amount spent by them if any, on survey & investigations, project formulations and infra-structure works of the Project up to the date of signing of the Memorandum of Agreement.
9. The scope of the work will be from concept to commissioning and operation thereafter including inter-alia survey and investigations, identification of transmission system for evacuation of power, preparation of Feasibility Report, Detailed Project Report, etc.
10. The Financial Strength of the bidder shall be considered for the selection of the developer. In the event, the bidder is an investment company, the Financial Strength of the promoting companies shall be taken into account. Bidders are requested to furnish their latest audited Financial Statements.
11. As the projects are proposed to be implemented on a Public Private Partnership model, weightage shall be given to bidders having relationship with Government or Government owned Companies in the areas of (a) arranging equity funding through SPVs/Asset Management Companies (b) joint ventures directly in the Power Generation SPVs or in the dedicated fuel supply companies dedicated to supply fuel to these Generation companies. Bidders are requested to furnish copies of the agreements supporting these claims.
12. Bidders, acting as the main promoter, are required to list out the Generation Projects, which have successfully achieved financial closure in the last 7 (seven) years. Copies of the LOIs of the Lenders to be submitted.
13. In respect of Clause-29 regarding free power and Clause-52 regarding Equity share of the detailed terms and conditions, the bidders shall fill up their offer in percentage. However, free power offer below 12% will summarily be rejected.
14. The State Govt. reserves the right to reject all or any of the bids without assigning any reason and will not be bound to accept the highest bidder.


